### 1 Children in the world

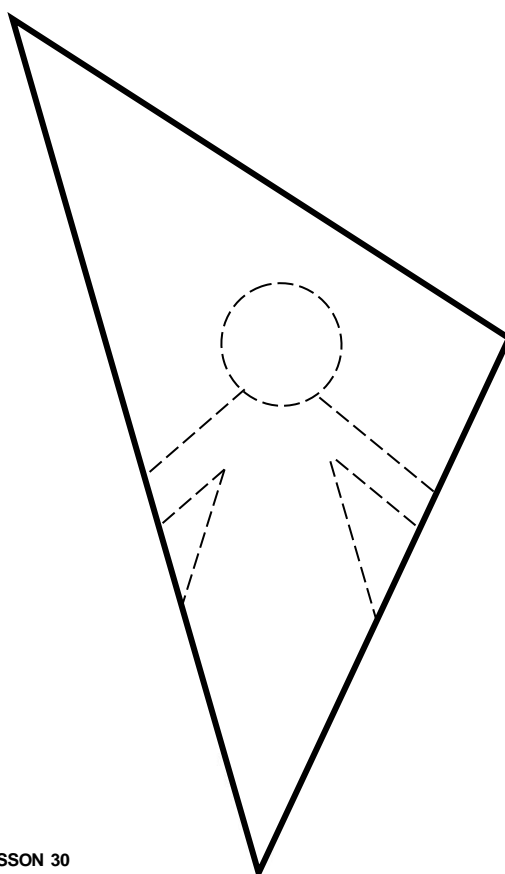


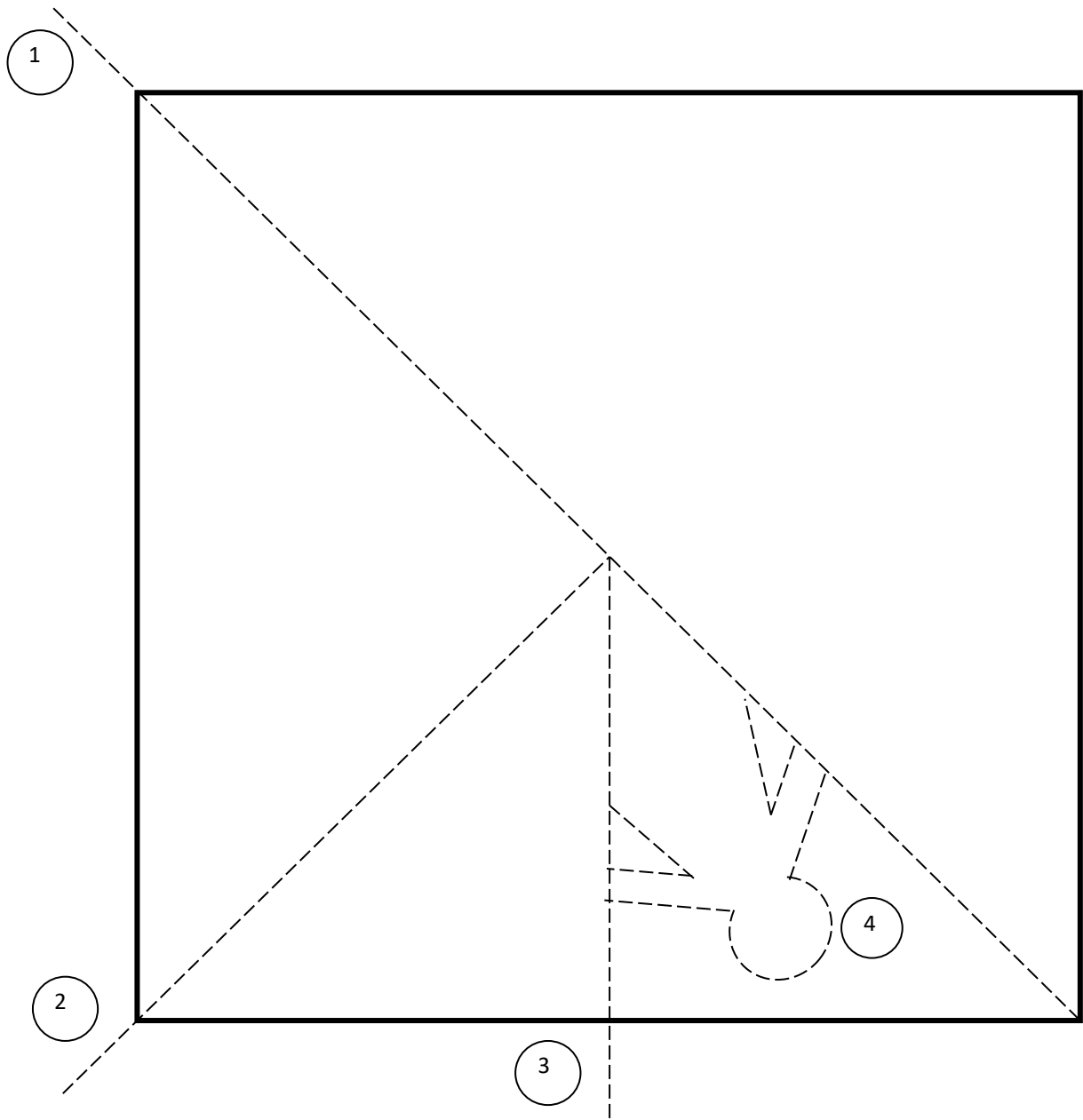
What do you need?

- scissors
- paper square (use template on the next page)
- colouring pencils

What are you going to do?

- 1 Fold the square into a triangle.
- 2 Fold this triangle in half and in half again.
- 3 Draw a child like the one in the example.
- 4 Cut out the child.
- 5 Unfold the paper.
- 6 Colour two opposite children.





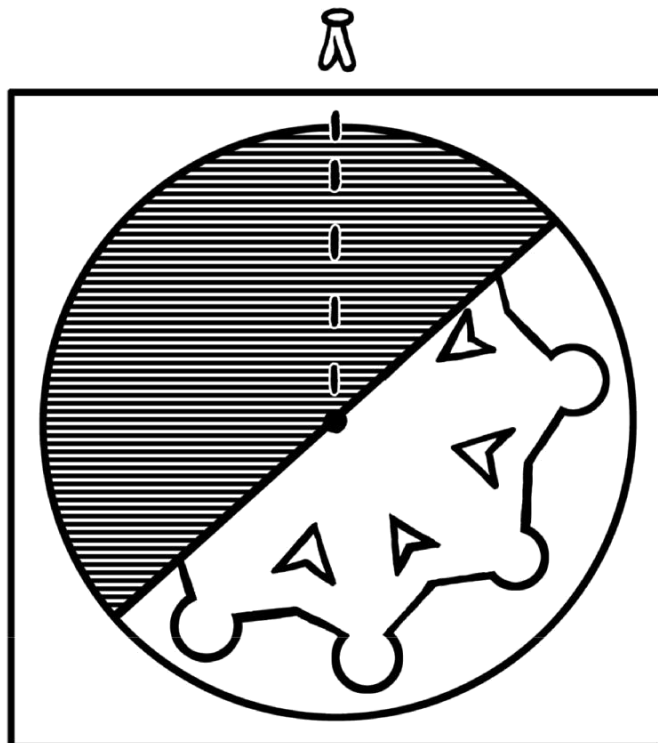
## 2 Day and night in the world

What do you need?

- scissors
- embroidery needle
- split pin

What are you going to do?

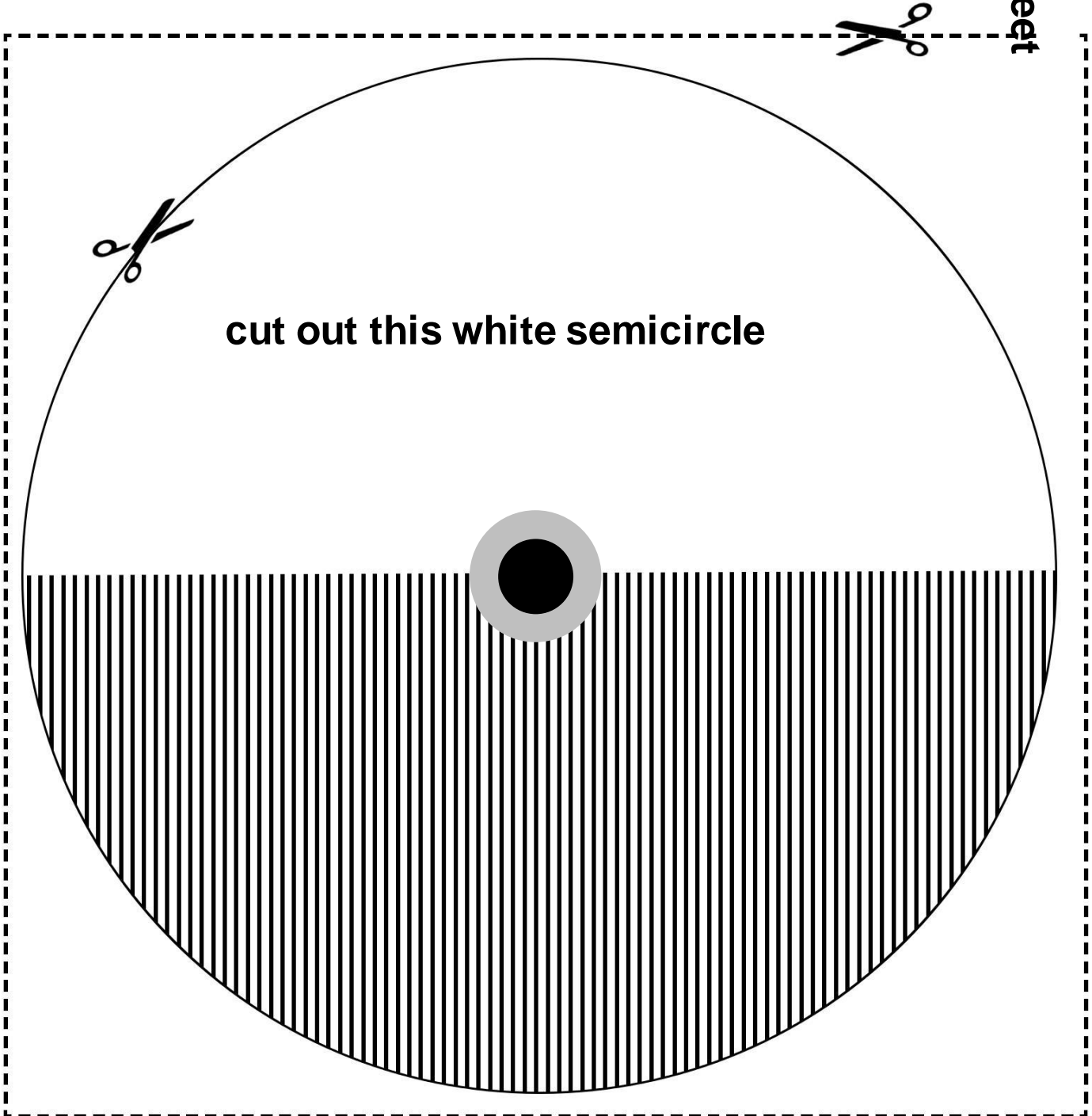
- 1 Cut out the square on the cut-out sheet.
- 2 Cut out the white semicircle in the square.  
Important! Make sure you do not cut out the black/grey circle in the centre.
- 3 Use the embroidery needle to prick a hole in the middle.
- 4 Prick a hole in the centre of the world from Task 1.
- 5 Place the square on top of the world.
- 6 Push the split pin through the two holes as shown in the drawing below.
- 7 Open the split pin to fasten it.
